

# Light Reflectance Values

The table below indicates Haworth High Pressure Laminate's light reflectance values (LRV).

Light Reflectance Value, or LRV, measures the amount of visible or usable light a surface reflects. LRV is expressed as a percentage from 0 to 100; the higher the number, the more visible light is reflected.
